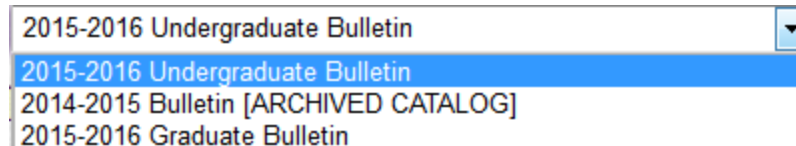
Online Bulletin User Guide





Bulletin Selection

- When accessing the Bulletin webpage (bulletin.montevallo.edu), the selection will default to the current undergraduate Bulletin
- To view a different online Bulletin, click on the drop-down box on the top-right of the screen and select a different Bulletin

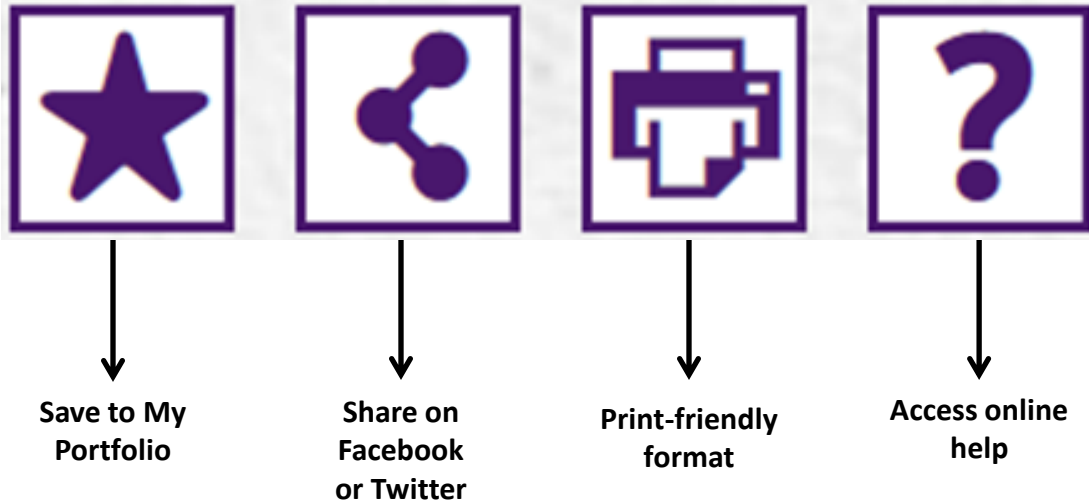
